The Simcoe County District School Board (SCDSB) is offering summer eLearning courses in July 2024 for current high school students or adult learners who are interested in earning a new credit or upgrading a previous mark.

Students can advance online learning skills, earn missed credits, or fast-track preparation for college or university in just four weeks. Online learning is fully supported by certified teachers who are available electronically daily.

Students will participate in 5.5 to 6 online study hours per day for the duration of the course. All courses run from July 2 to 26 unless otherwise noted.
